

Page Two: **7th Annual Summer Camp and Family Vacation Show**

No exhibit will be permitted to set-up until full exhibit fees have been received.

As an Exhibitor you agree to abide by all laws, rules and regulations of any government or regulatory body and the Oregon Convention Center. This includes, but is not limited to, abiding by all Fire Marshall rules and regulations. Exhibitor is responsible for the space leased and shall not mar or deface the premises. Exhibitor shall not drive nor permit to be driven any nails, tacks or screws in any part of the building. Exhibitor shall not affix any tape or any other adhesive materials on painted surfaces. Exhibitor agrees to reimburse the facility and/or decorator for any loss or damage to the premises or equipment occurring in the space leased.

Exhibitors agree to staff booth during all regular show hours. Booths not occupied by 9:00am March 13, will be reassigned as deemed best for the interest of the Show without any rebates whatsoever. All displays must be kept up until end of Show, 4:00pm Sunday. Exhibit space may not be sublet or apportioned without prior written approval.

Aisles and overhead spaces remain under the control of Summershow and no signs, decorations or special exhibits will be permitted except by written permission from Summershow. All exhibits and personnel must remain within the leased space. Exhibitor may not erect signs or display products in such a manner as to obstruct the view, disadvantageously affect the display of other Exhibitors. No interference with the light or space of another Exhibitor will be permitted. Noise resulting from the exhibitor space must not interfere with the other exhibitors.

No food items or drinks are to be sold for on-premise consumption. Any items, beverages or samples intended for on-site consumption must conform to a sampling policy and requires written permission from the facility.

NO HELIUM BALLOONS ARE PERMITTED INSIDE

All booths are assigned at the discretion of Show management. All exhibitors agree to allow their image to be copied in either film or print for promotion or advertising.

If desired by you, **insurance** must be obtained at your own cost and expense. Summershow, our insurance company, Sponsors and the Convention Center assume no risk for losses, injuries or mysterious disappearances of any kind. By the acceptance of this agreement, you expressly release both from any and all liability for any damage, injury or loss to any person or goods which may arise from the rental, occupation, or activity in said space.

If we are unable to hold the show because of war, fire, strike, public catastrophe, act of God, or other cause beyond our control, we will refund a proportionate share of the balance of the aggregate exhibit fees received which remain after deducting expenses.
